 - Energy savings of about 70%.
 - Monetary savings over the bulbs lifetime of about \$35 per bulb.

 - Rope Caulk to fill in holes around windows and doors to keep hot or cold air inside.
 - Monetary savings of up to \$100 a year
 - Reduction of up to 1,350 pounds of CO₂ emissions a year.²
